Deborah wanted to return to Ghana with us in July but we found out that PCC withdrew her student immigration status from February to May this year even though she was in school, she therefore cannot leave the States until she can prove to Immigration that she was In school. The Judge who was scheduled to hear her case said there are too many cases and so Deborah must wait till March next year.

Please be in prayer with us because we need her to help with the Radio Station. We praise the Lord for our trip to the States this year. It was a trip filled with blessings and trials.

SHIPPING OF SUPPLIES

We thank the Mission groups, churches and individuals who donated various items to help with the ministry here especially, Bethesda Mission, Mission Central, CMTS Inc all of Pennsylvania, Emmanuel Bible Church in Ohio. We also thank Yellow&Roadway Trucking for donating their Terminal for loading the container,

The shipment arrived in Ghana on the 22nd of August and we cleared it from the port on September 4th. We have given out some of the books, food items and first aid as well as health packs to children in Bible Baptist Church and children in our school. We are planning to make some donations to the Mentally challenged in Accra and the Orphanage in the Volta Region in October.

CHURCH PLANTING

The current economic crisis is not leaving us out here in Ghana, members of our churches are having difficulties in meeting the needs of their children, so when the supplies got here in September we gave food items, to the families and stationary to students in Bible Baptist Church. Some of the High school students have returned to school so this

is having an impact on our attendance, especially in the Sunday school and the King of Kings youth Club. We expect them to return during the Christmas break.

We are planning to travel to northern Ghana to visit the outreach churches at the end of October. By which time we hope the rains will stop, at present the rains are causing a lot of havoc. Roads have been washed away, people have lost their houses. Be in prayer for our brethren in Northern Ghana. We are planning to stop and see the Chief in the Ashante Region who has invited us to come to his village and minister the Word to his people..

ALIVE FM RADIO MINISTRY

We give God the glory for all the brethren who he has burdened to help with the Radio Ministry.

We are now waiting for word from the National communication for our License. We were informed that a final committee is to sit to give us the License .

This has allowed us to do more physical work on the Office. We praise the Lord for the New Exciter that Emmanuel Bible Church of Ohio bought for us. We also have the RF cable and a dear brother here built an antenna to mount on the 70ft Mast. Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised.

Now we can reach a 25 mile radius with over 9 million inhabitants. Our God is truly a great God of wonders.

Be In prayer for the following needs for the Radio Station.

- 1.) The License
- 2.) A good amplifier
- 3.) Sponsors for programs - we are asking for at least \$20 donations for 30 minute to 60 minute programs. This will help us take care of the station staff and maintenance of equipment.

EDUCATION. BIPS AND BIPS/SECTECH.

The Bible school will re-open next Month, we are trusting the Lord will bring more students this year.

The High school will also re-open in October. We will update you in our Christmas Newsletter. The economic problems is not getting better so we will need \$100 per month for three years to train a pastor, and between \$50 and \$75 per month to support a village pastor.

The High School is facing similar problems. This year a lot of parents are saying they cannot send their children to school because they do not have the funds and this is not only High school, from K-1 to 9th grade, the current government is trying but it simply cannot do it all so the President is calling on Churches, NGO's to assist.

We want to encourage Groups in the churches such as Sunday school, ladies, women and men fellowships, youth groups and families to consider how they can help these needy children as a Mission project.

The Grade school has re-opened and we now have 26 children in K1-K2, 23 children in 1st to 6th Grade. The number of children who reported when school re-opened in September was about 80 but some of the parents said they cannot afford even \$1 per day as feeding fee. Some are Orphans.

Please be in prayer for our Country. Let us know if you can help in some way. We provide books, and stationary so if you can help; it will be very much appreciated. If these children do not go to school they will grow up to become drug dealers and armed robbers. We have seen this in the past but this has to stop.

This year we will be going to the Mentally Handicaped, some Orphanages, and Hospitals before the end of the year

MORINGA PROJECT

We are planning to adopt some villages to help with the malaria epidemic by providing them with the Moringa Tea for at least 60 days to prove to all that Moringa is the solution to Malaria. Treated mosquito nets can only control but not cure.

“In many developing nations, malaria is one of the leading threats to the life of a child, resulting in some 800,000 child deaths per year globally. Each year, malaria kills more than 1 million people...” Seekingjustice.com. This is worse than HIV&AIDS.

We need funds to dig a well to water the plants during the dry season. A young man just informed me that he can dig the well for \$1500 instead of the current \$4000. Can you help us help our people?

Do let us know.
