Thanksgiving, is a season to pursue and thank the faithfulness of God through another year. I also believe it continues through December.

This year we both saw the Lord unfolding amazing opportunities and equally very difficult challenges. I know we can say a big AMEN to that.

The challenges have enabled us to focus on our PRIORITIES, and as we look back on 2009, I can say that Personally, as a family and ministry, we have had one of the most productive years and are seeing the ministry growing:

THE SCHOOL

We have seen a dramatic rise in student number from Kindergarten to Senior High. It is said a picture is worth more than a thousand words. Total number of students now stands at 120. The pastoral training is also on cause. Six young men are under-studying to be pastors. We had a surprise visit from one of our past graduates who is now planting churches in Liberia. Pastor Peter Tooman. Brother Peter graduated in 1997, and left to Liberia his hometown to serve the Lord please be in prayers with him, there is a lot of needs there still. **(see student pictures below)**

SHIPPING OF SUPPLIES

We are now distributing the supplies we got from the Mission groups, churches and individuals who donated various items to help with the ministry especially, Bethesda Mission, Mission Central, CMTS Inc all of Pennsylvania, Emmanuel Bible Church in Ohio. The Orphanages and the needy children in our care all very thankful to the Lord and the donors. **(See pictures below)**

CHURCH PLANTING

We will not be able to visit the field in Northern Ghana due to what the rains did, so we have hope January 2009 will be the time. The brother who is coordinating the work was here for a few days with encouraging words on the growth of the churches.

ALIVE FM RADIO MINISTRY

We had a strong rain storm that affected a component in our NEW TRANSMITTER, which reduced the range of our transmissions but that has been solved now. We had a Mission Team of ten brethren from the USA visiting us. They were interviewed and preached on ALIVE FM what a blessing. To God be the Glory.

We are still waiting for a word from the National Communication for our License. They wrote to us again informing us that a final committee is yet to sit to give us the License.

Be In prayer for the following needs for the Radio Station:

- 1.) The License
- 2.) A good amplifier
- 3.) Sponsors of programs. We are asking for at least \$20 donation for a 30 minute to 60 minute program. This will help us take care of the staff expenses of the station and maintenance of equipment.

MORINGA PROJECT

We are still planning to adopt some villages to help with the malaria epidemic, by providing them with the Moringa Tea for at least 60 day to prove to all that Moringa is the solution to Malaria. Treated mosquito nets can only control but not cure. We need the funds to dig a well to water the plants during the dry season. A young man just informed me that he can dig the Well for \$1500. Since we are not getting the funding my son has developed a Web site for us to promote the Moringa project. This way people can donate or buy the product either way they will be sponsoring the project to help the people in need. The web site is: www.gsmoringaproduct.com
