#### **MINISTRY**

Everything is fine here, school started on September 7th, we are waiting for the supplies to get here on the 9th or 10th of October.

To all of you who drove for miles to Mission Central to bring in supplies, those who gave various items, those who helped at Mission Central in Mechanicsburg, Pa, the Director and all the Volunteers, we say Bravo!!! May the Lord richly bless you all.

## **NORTHERN GHANA PROJECT**

We are waiting for the supplies to arrive to go to Northern Ghana in early November. We praise the Lord for the donations for the JIM B water project, we got a small drilling machine that we intend to use to drill at Jim B, the only problem is that we need an over 90 PSI Air Compressor some PVC pipes a generator to be able to use the drilling machine. This means we have to wait till more funds come in. We have raised about \$6000 so far for this water project. Our plan B & plan C, is to get a small tractor or a Donkey to bring the water from the Lake, get two holding tanks, one for the Donkey use and one for the Village. This will be an interim measure. Be in prayer with us, Our God is able.

We also need funds still for the Clinic on the Island of Ada Kopey.

## **CHURCHES**

Three new churches are coming up in the town called Damango, also in the Northern Region of Ghana. Our greatest need is funds to help the Village pastors. These three Churches will bring the number now to eight. Our Goal is twenty by the end of 2011. Praise the Lord for those who are helping the Village pastors. We will soon send you their pictures as you give and pray for them.

## **ALIVE RADIO MINISTRY**

We went off for some time but we are back on Air still praying and waiting for our operation License. Join us in prayers Jer. 33:3.

## **MORINGA PROJECT**
